The Old Baldy Foundation is a 5OI(c)3 nonprofit organization dedicated to the preservation of The Old Baldy Lighthouse and educational outreach of the rich Maritime History of the Cape Fear Region. All event proceeds directly benefit this mission.

The Old Baldy Foundation hosts an annual event "National Lighthouse Weekend" to honor Old Baldy's maritime history. In typical years, the weekend is filled with festivities celebrating the beloved lighthouse. Due to the ongoing situation with COVID-19, many of these events have been cancelled. We have decided to include an artisanal marketplace due to success we have had in the past with this event and its socially distant nature!

There is a \$75 fee to be a vendor at the NC Treasures Market Place. This fee includes two round trip ferry tickets to the Island with tram service upon arrival (46\$ value). We are asking that all vendors donate 15% of their sales to The Old Baldy Foundation. This is a selective event with vendors being hand picked.

All vendors will be provided with a table and chairs.. Additional tables will be available to rent. You are welcome to bring a pop up tent to provide shade for the event. Each vendor will be responsible for bringing their supplies to Bald Head Island. We are happy to provide individual recommendations on transportation and set up, as Bald Head Island requires more logistics than other sites.
